FIXED PRICING FOR NATURAL GAS AGGREGATION PROGRAM**

City of Washington Court House, Ohio (August 25, 2010) – The City of Washington Court House announces that it has established a fixed price for natural gas for members of the city's aggregation program. Residents and small businesses that enroll in the city's natural gas program will be supplied by Vectren Source at the rate of \$0.674 per hundred cubic feet (Ccf) for September 2010 to March 2011. Current program customers will automatically receive the new price. The program leverages the combined buying power of homeowners to deliver competitively priced natural gas.
