**THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE ANNOUNCES  
INITIAL PRICING FOR NATURAL GAS AGGREGATION PROGRAM**

**City of Washington Court House, Ohio (March 6, 2009)** – The City of Washington Court House announces that it has established the first year pricing for natural gas for members of the city's aggregation program. Residents and small businesses that enroll in the city's natural gas program will be supplied by Vectren Source at the rate of \$0.6143 per hundred cubic feet (Ccf) for April and May 2009. From June 2009 through March 2010, the price charged to Aggregation Members shall be a guaranteed savings of \$0.05 per Ccf discount off of the Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio monthly Standard Service Offer price. For the period April 2010 through April 2011 the price charged to Aggregation Members shall be a variable rate unless fixed at a later date.

Vectren Source is preparing to send notices to all eligible residents in late March. If you wish to participate, you need do nothing once the letter is received. Vectren Source will take care of enrolling or renewing your account. If you do not wish to participate, simply return the bottom portion of the opt-out notice or contact Vectren Source directly at 1-800-770-5976 and your account will be removed from the aggregation program.

Residents and businesses not receiving a letter can call Vectren Source to join this program. "This pricing structure guarantees savings and takes advantage of a drop in the natural gas market. We hope residents will take advantage of the program," said, Thomas Bellish, President, Buckeye Energy Brokers, consultant for the City.

"Given the volatility of natural gas prices over the last two years, we believe that the initial price and the \$.05 per Ccf discount for one year is a very competitive price. We look forward to serving the community's residents," said Vectren Source President Greg Collins. Washington Court House residents who are served by another supplier will not receive an opt-out notice but may seek enrollment in the city's aggregation program by calling Vectren Source by April 15, 2009 at 1-800-770-5976. Residents served by other suppliers are encouraged to review the terms and conditions of their current supplier agreement before enrolling as cancellation fees may apply. New participants in the program must be current on their Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio bill and cannot be part of the utility's Percentage of Income Payment Program (PIPP).
