

**ORDINANCE NO. 19 -2008**

**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18-2007 BY PROVIDING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO DURING FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2008.**

**SECTION 4:** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
