

RESOLUTION NO. R22-2005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING JOSEPH J. DENEN CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FY2005 FORMULA ALLOCATION PROGRAM, AND ACCEPTING APPLICATION, IF FUNDED.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Development provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of addressing local needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Washington Court House desires to participate in the Program to receive financial assistance for streetscape improvements under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Allocation Program in the amount of \$ 72,000; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Washington Court House must direct and authorize the City manager to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House authorizes the City manager as the official representative of the State of Ohio Department of Development, Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Allocation Program, and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for submission. The City Manager is also authorized to enter into contracts and solicit bids for projects associated with this grant.

SECTION 2. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Allocation Program.

SECTION 3. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House hereby understands and agrees to participate in the Program, and will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

SECTION 4. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House commits to providing engineering services of \$10,000.00 to complete engineered drawings and supervision of the Gregg Street, Phase III Improvements.

SECTION 5. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House commits to perform the close out audit.

SECTION 6. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House hereby authorizes the firm of Michael Secoy & Associates to administer the FY 2005 CDBG Allocation Program, if funded.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
