

RESOLUTION NO. R23-2005

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE APPRECIATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE TO PRIVATE CITIZENS AND PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS THAT ASSISTED WITH THE IMPROVEMENTS COMPLETED AT THE WASHINGTON CEMETERY.

WHEREAS, the Washington Cemetery has benefited from the services of numerous private citizens and private community organizations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and Administration desire to express their thanks and good will for these services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Washington Court House in an effort to include all persons and organizations so engaged in the improvement of the Washington Cemetery with the phrase, "Friends of the Cemetery".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the City Council of the City of Washington Court House with the complete support of the Administration of the City of Washington Court House declares formally its appreciation and recognition of numerous completed and future improvements to the Washington Cemetery by the Friends of the Cemetery.

SECTION 2: That the term Friends of the Cemetery shall be interpreted to include all private citizens, private civic organizations and private businesses who have donated to the Washington Cemetery their labor, financial support, leadership skills, expert knowledge and loving devotion.

SECTION 3: That the City Council of the City of Washington Court House hereby declares its understanding and appreciation of the special place the Washington Cemetery holds in the heart of the community.

SECTION 4: That the City Council of the City of Washington Court House commits its own symbolic act of recognition in an effort to communicate to the community how events in recent years at the Washington Cemetery have contributed to a true sense of community within the City of Washington Court House and Fayette County.

SECTION 5: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from the earliest date permitted by law.
