

RESOLUTION NO. R26-2005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING JOSEPH J. DENEN, CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FAYETTE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE PROVISION OF PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICES.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Washington Court House has deemed it necessary and proper to secure Public Defender Services for indigent persons; and

WHEREAS, The provision of Public Defender services to indigents meets certain requirements of the system of law to which we are all accustomed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Joseph J. Denen, City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Fayette County Commissioners for the provision of Public Defender services in the amount of **Thirty One Thousand Seven-Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars and Forty Cents (\$31,732.40).**

SECTION 2. That said agreement for the provision of Public Defender Services is attached to this Resolution and marked "Exhibit A" and is herein incorporated by reference and no deviation from said agreement is authorized.

SECTION 3. That the agreement shall cover the period beginning July 1, 2005 and ending June 30, 2006, and that the cost for such agreement shall be paid for out of funds appropriated for such purposes.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date permitted by law.

RESOLUTION NO. R27- 2005

DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF A RENEWAL LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE.

The Council of the City of Washington Court House met in regular session on the 26th day of July, 2005 at 105 North Main Street, Washington Court House, Ohio with the following members present:

Mr./Mrs. Chrisman moved the following resolution:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO:

At least two-thirds of all the members thereto elected concurring:

SECTION 1: That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy taxes at the maximum rate authorized by Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.02 on the taxable property in the City of Washington Court House, will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said City of Washington Court House, and that it is necessary for the purpose of providing additional funds for operation of the City of Washington Court House Police Department, that taxes be levied on the taxable property in said City of Washington Court House for a period of five (5) years, at a rate in excess of such maximum rate authorized by said Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.02.

SECTION 2: The proposed levy will be a renewal levy at the rate of one mill for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to Ten Cents (\$0.10) for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation.

SECTION 3: The levy shall be placed on the tax list and duplicate and in effect for five (5) years for the years 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010, if approved by the voters.

SECTION 4. That the Clerk be, and is hereby, directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Fayette County, Ohio, in order that said Board of Elections may make the necessary arrangements for the submission of such questions to the electors of said City of Washington Court House at the November 8, 2005 election, as provided by law (Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19, 5705.191, and 5705.25).
