

RESOLUTION NO. R46-2005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE STATE ISSUE II PROGRAM AND THE LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission an agency of the State of Ohio, is authorized to provide local subdivisions with up to \$120 million per year for infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS, a second program, Local Transportation Program will provide an additional \$55 to \$60 million per year for funding local infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, said inventory and plan indicate certain projects in need of funding within our jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby endorses and supports the five-year infrastructure improvement program of the City of Washington Court House.

SECTION 2. That Joseph J. Denen, City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for, and if awarded to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Public Works Commission to carry out an agreement to approve said programs, and that Joseph J. Denen, City Manager is authorized to execute said agreement.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period permitted by law.
