

RESOLUTION NO. R9-2006

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CHIP) AND ACCEPTING THE GRANT IF FUNDED.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Department of Development, provides financial assistance to local governments under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME and Ohio Housing Trust Fund (OHTF) for the purpose of addressing local needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Washington Court House desires to participate in the Program to receive financial assistance for Community Housing Improvements under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant CHIP Program; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Washington Court House must direct and authorize the City manager of the City of Washington Court House to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be requested.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House authorizes the City Manager as the official representative in the State of Ohio, Department of Development, Small Cities Community Development Block Grant CHIP Program, and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for submission. The City Manager is also authorized to enter in to contracts and let bids for projects associated with this grant.

SECTION 2. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant CHIP Program.


SECTION 3. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House hereby understands and agrees to participate in the Program, and require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

SECTION 4. That the Council of the City of Washington Court House commits up to \$20,000.00 to perform the close out audit and provide office space.

SECTION 5. The Council of the City of Washington Court House authorizes the firm of Michael Secoy and Associates to administer the FY 2006 CDBG CHIP Program, if funded.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
