

RESOLUTION NO. R2 -2011

DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF A RENEWAL LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE LEVY AS ENUNCIATED IN O.R.C. §5705.19(I) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING FIRE APPARATUS, APPLIANCES, BUILDINGS, OR SITE, THEREFORE, OR SOURCES OF WATER SUPPLY AND MATERIALS THEREFORE, OR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF LINES OF FIRE ALARM TELEGRAPH, OR THE PAYMENT OF PERMANENT, PART-TIME, OR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS OR FIREFIGHTING COMPANIES TO OPERATE THE SAME, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF THE FIREFIGHTERS' CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER O.R.C. §742.34, OR THE PURCHASE OF AMBULANCE EQUIPMENT, OR THE PROVISION OF AMBULANCE, PARAMEDIC, OR OTHER EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATED BY A FIRE DEPARTMENT OR FIREFIGHTING COMPANY.

Mr. Roby moved the following resolution:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO:

At least two-thirds of all the members thereto elected concurring:

SECTION 1: That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy taxes at the maximum rate authorized by Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.02 on the taxable property in the City of Washington Court House, will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said City of Washington Court House, and that it is necessary for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefore, or sources of water supply and materials therefore, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm

telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighter employers' contribution required under section 742.34 of the Revised Code, or the purchase of ambulance equipment, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company of the City of Washington Court House, that taxes be levied on the taxable property in said City of Washington Court House for a period of five (5) years, at a rate in excess of such maximum rate authorized by said Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.02.

SECTION 2: The proposed levy will be a renewal levy at the rate of one mill for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to Ten Cents (\$0.10) for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation.

SECTION 3: The levy shall be placed on the tax list and duplicate and in effect for five (5) years for the years 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015, if approved by the voters.

SECTION 4. That the Clerk be, and is hereby, directed to certify a copy of this resolution, along with the resolution requesting the county auditor certify to the City the amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy and the county auditor's certificate of available revenue to the Board of Elections of Fayette County, Ohio, in order that said Board of Elections may make the necessary arrangements for the submission of such questions to the electors of said City of Washington Court House at the May 3, 2011 election, as provided by law (Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19, 5705.191, and 5705.25).
