

RESOLUTION NO. R 38 -2011

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING JOSEPH J. DENEN, CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FAYETTE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE PROVISION OF PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICES.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Washington Court House has deemed it necessary and proper to secure Public Defender Services for indigent persons; and

WHEREAS, The provision of Public Defender services to indigents meets certain requirements of the system of law to which we are all accustomed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Joseph J. Denen, City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Fayette County Commissioners for the provision of Public Defender services in the amount of **Thirty-Eight Thousand, Ten Dollars and zero cents (\$38,010.00).** Pro-rated quarterly in the amount of 9,502.50.

SECTION 2. That said agreement for the provision of Public Defender Services is attached to this Resolution and marked "Exhibit A" and is herein incorporated by reference and no deviation from said agreement is authorized.

SECTION 3. That the agreement shall cover the period beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012 and that the cost for such agreement shall be paid for out of funds appropriated for such purposes.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest date permitted by law.
