

**SERVICE, SAFETY, and RECREATION COMMITTEE**

**Monday, November 2, 2009**

The Service, Safety and Recreation Committee met in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room of 105 North Main Street on Monday, November 2, 2009 at 8:00 A.M. Mr. Steve Jennings presided and those in attendance were; Mr. Ben Roby, Council Chairman, Mr. Dale Lynch, Council Member, Mr. Ted Hawk, Council Member, Mr. Dwight Hedrick, Council Member, Mr. Joe Denen, City Manager, Mr. Joe Burbage, Service Director, Mr. Jim Heath, Assistant Service Director, Mr. Mark Pitstick, City Attorney and Mr. Alan Dawson, Wastewater Supervisor.

1. The Committee benefited from a review of the Police & Fire Building by Mr. Joe Denen. The Committee noted that a building tour would be completed on Tuesday, November 3, at 3pm. The Committee benefited from a review of the Open House and Dedication Committee.
2. The Committee benefited from a verbal update given of the Fayette County Dog Warden Services by Mr. Joe Denen.
3. The Committee benefited from a review of all current city projects. The Committee noted that the Sixth Street project had been completed.
4. The Committee discussed in length the septage rate worksheet and noted that the rate was based on an average of rates from the surrounding communities. The Committee recommended that the Administration move forward with implementation of the rate increase for septage.
5. The Committee discussed in length the proposed elimination of traffic signals listed below, and recommended the following changes be completed after the first of the 2010 year:
  - 1.) Dayton Avenue and Van Deman - remove light and Dayton Avenue will become a through street.
  - 2.) Dayton Avenue and Oakland Avenue - remove flashing light.
  - 3.) Paint Street and North Fayette Street - remove the flashing light, intersection will remain a four way stop.
  - 4.) South Fayette Street and 100 block of E. Elm St. (by Sunnyside School)- remove the flashing light, South Fayette Street will become a through street and the stop sign will remain only for Elm Street traffic.
