

**SERVICE, SAFETY, and RECREATION COMMITTEE**

**Monday, May 4, 2009**

The Service, Safety and Recreation Committee met in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room of 105 North Main Street on Monday, May 4, 2009 at 8:00 A.M. Mr. Steve Jennings presided and those in attendance were; Mr. Ted Hawk, Council Member, Mr. Dale Lynch, Council Member, Mr. Dwight Hedrick, Council Member, Mr. Ben Roby, Council Chairman; Mr. Joe Denen, City Manager; Mr. Joe Burbage, Service Director; Mr. Jim Heath, Assistant Service Director; Mr. Brian Hottinger, Police Chief, and Mr. Mark Pitstick, City Attorney. Chief Fowler was absent.

1. The Committee benefited from a general report of the Washington Police Department
2. The Committee benefited from a review of the Fayette County Dog Warden Incident report for the month ending April 30, 2009.
3. The Committee benefited from a review of the Police & Fire Building by Mr. Joe Denen. Mr. Denen advised the Committee of the tour that would be held on Tuesday, May 5th at 3pm.
4. The Administration advised the Committee that the Traffic light signalization project had begun.
5. The Committee recommended that the Administration begin the process of removing the traffic signal located at the intersection of Paint and North after the old Middle School closes.
6. The Committee benefited from a review of the stimulus application results. Due to the requirements submitted by the Ohio EPA., the Committee recommended that the Wastewater Treatment Plant Project continue to the 30% design completion status and noted that the Administration would continue actions toward stimulus funding.
7. The Administration advised the Committee of issues regarding the seals at the Belle-Aire Lift Station. The Committee noted that the Administration would continue to monitor the issue.
8. The Committee was advised of a request made by the Fayette County Pony League for the use of two city owned areas for a period between August 15, 2009 and October 30, 2009. The Committee recommended that permission be granted for the request.
9. The Committee noted a request from the "Gathering Place", for three community outreach events to be held on June 7<sup>th</sup>, July 26<sup>th</sup> and August 23<sup>rd</sup>, at the Eyman Park facilities. The Committee recommended that permission be granted for use of the facilities for the events.
