

## SERVICE, SAFETY, and RECREATION COMMITTEE

Monday, June 1, 2009

The Service, Safety and Recreation Committee met in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room of 105 North Main Street on Monday, June 1, 2009 at 8:00 A.M. Mr. Dale Lynch presided and those in attendance were; Mr. Ted Hawk, Council Member, Mr. Dwight Hedrick, Council Member, Mr. Ben Roby, Council Chairman; Mr. Joe Denen, City Manager; Mr. Joe Burbage, Service Director; Mr. Jim Heath, Assistant Service Director; Mr. Brian Hottinger, Police Chief, Mr. Mark Pitstick, City Attorney and Mr. Ben Keller, citizen. Chief Fowler was absent.

1. The Committee benefited from a general report of the Washington Police Department.
2. The Committee benefited from a review of the Fayette County Dog Warden Incident report for the month ending May 31, 2009.
3. The Committee benefited from a review of the Police & Fire Building by Mr. Joe Denen. Mr. Denen advised the Committee of the tour that would be held on Tuesday, June 2, at 3pm.
4. The Administration advised the Committee that the Traffic light signalization project was progressing.
5. Mr. Ben Keller, addressed the Committee regarding actions of the City Manager at a previous unrelated meeting.
6. The Committee discussed the lighting issues at the intersection of Robinson Road and State Route 753. The Committee recommended that the item be placed on the next Safety, Service and Recreation Agenda.
7. The Administration advised the Committee of issues regarding the Belle-Aire Lift Station. The Committee noted that the Administration had received the P.T.I for the project and the lift station would be moved closer to State Route 41 S on the current residential property.
8. The Committee was advised that the City Planning Commission had approved Felmar Development and that the plat had been recorded.
9. The Committee noted the positive response from the public regarding the Washington Cemetery in reaction of the letter to the editor.
10. The Committee noted that communication had been made with the management of the "Warehouse" located on Elm Street regarding a complaint made by a citizen of disruptive behavior at the teen facility.
11. The Administration advised the Committee that the YMCA Fishing Derby would be held on June 20<sup>th</sup> from 10 to 2pm located at the ponds near the City Pool.
12. The Committee was advised that inspections had been passed for the City pool and that the opening day would be June 3, 2009.
13. The Committee noted their concerns regarding the disposal of the recycling bins within the community. The Administration advised that a meeting would be scheduled with the Solid Waste District regarding the concerns.
